HRADF pre-qualifies eight (8) interested parties for the new concession of the Attica Motorway

The Board of Directors of the Hellenic Republic Asset Development Fund (HRADF), a member of the GROWTHFUND — The National Fund of Greece, convened today and pre-qualified the interested parties that meet the eligibility criteria to participate in Phase B (Binding Offers Phase) of the tender process regarding the new services concession agreement in relation to financing, operation, maintenance and exploitation of Attica Motorway, one of the most important road infrastructures in Greece, for a duration of twenty-five (25) years.

Following the signing of the relevant confidentiality agreement, the pre-qualified investors will receive the documentation of phase B' of the tender process (submission of Binding Offers) and will be granted access to the virtual data room (V.D.R.), where data and information related to the Attica Motorway will be uploaded.

Attica Motorway is a modern motorway extending along 70 km, constructed on a concession basis during the 1990s. It constitutes the ring road of the greater metropolitan area of Athens and the backbone of the road network of the whole Attica prefecture. It is an urban motorway with two separate directional carriageways, each consisting of 3 lanes and an emergency lane (hard shoulder). In addition, the suburban railway of Athens has been constructed in the central reservation of Attica Motorway.

The Attica Motorway is part of the PATHE (Patra - Athens - Thessaloniki - Evzoni) road axis and connects the Athens – Lamia National Road with the Athens – Korinthos National Road, bypassing the center of Athens. The motorway has controlled access points and consists of two sections, which are perpendicular to one another: the Elefsina – Stavros – Spata A/P motorway, extending along approximately 52 km, and the Imittos Western Peripheral Motorway, extending



along approx. 13 km. In addition, part of the Aegaleo Western Peripheral Motorway extending along around 5 km also forms part of the Attica Motorway.
