Responses to clarification requests submitted by Interested Parties in connection with the Invitation to submit an Expression of Interest for the acquisition of a majority shareholding in DEPA Commercial (the “Invitation”). Unless otherwise specified herein, capitalized terms used in the present shall bear the same meaning as in the Invitation.

1.	4.4.1, 4.4.2 A) With regard to clause 4.4.1 of the Invitation (“Technical Requirement”), our understanding is that a company owning and operating crude oil tankers and liquefied natural gas vessels meets the Technical Requirement described in that clause, given that in such a way it demonstrates business activity both in the oil and gas sector. Please confirm. B) Further, regarding clause 4.4.2 of the Invitation, our understanding is that a Consortium consisting of two members, of which one is a company demonstrating business activity both in the oil and gas sector (“Technical Consortium Member”), as per the above, fulfils as a whole the technical requirements of the Invitation. Please confirm	A) This is confirmed. B) This is confirmed, the Technical Requirement must be met by at least one (1) member of the consortium, which participates in the equity ownership of the consortium either directly by such member or through its Technical Affiliate

2.	7.2, 7.3, Annex I, II, III, IV	Our understanding is that the Invitation does not require the signatures to be authenticated. Please confirm. In this context please clarify whether the signatures in the Solemn Declarations of Annexes III and IV should be authenticated, as stated in the templates on pages 27 and 28 of the Invitation (“[Place],[date] [Signature] [Authentication of the signature]”), taking into consideration that such authentication is not mentioned in the templates of the Solemn Declarations of Annexes I and II.	According to the Invitation, the solemn declarations of Annex III and Annex IV require an authentication of signature of the signatory thereof (as correctly mentioned, there is an explicit reference to this effect at the end of each of the above Annexes). To the contrary, the solemn declarations of Annex I and Annex II do not require such authentication given that they constitute solemn declarations of law 1599/1986. Other than the above requirement explicitly referred to in the Invitation, no other authentication, notarisation or apostille is required upon submission by the Interested Parties of the Expression of Interest. However, notwithstanding the above and as per clause 10.3 of the Invitation, the Fund reserves the right to require at any stage that any documents submitted by any Interested Party shall be authenticated, notarized, and/or be accompanied by apostille certification.
